This is a list of school supplies needed per grade level (LABEL ALL SUPPLIES WITH CHILD'S NAME)

GRADE 1 - School bag, 2 boxes of crayons 24 count, 4 oz Elmer's glue, 4 large glue sticks, Fiskars scissors, 2 pink pearl erasers, 1 composition notebooks (**WIDE RULED**), 2 folders, 1 inch binder, 12" ruler showing inches & centimeters, 2 boxes washable "classic" markers, 6 dry erase markers, 1 pencil pouch for math toolkit and 1 pencil pouch or box for supplies, 2 packages 12 count #2 pencils (yellow Dixon/Ticondaroga work best), 1 box ziploc bags and 2 large boxes of tissues, 1 tub of baby wipes, 1 pack of colored pencils, 1 pack white card stock, 1 pack colored card stock, 1 watercolor paint set.

Please make sure **all** items (every crayon and marker) are labeled with your child's name or initials in permanent marker. Throughout the year, please ask your child if any supplies need replenishing.

GRADE 2 - School bag, 3 packages of 12count #2 plain yellow pencils (**decorative pencils jam in our pencil sharpener**), 2 Pink Pearl erasers, 1 box of 24 crayons, pencil pouch (**no boxes**), Elmer's school glue, 2 large glue sticks, 3 folders with pockets and fasteners (**not plastic**), 3 large boxes of tissues, 1 box of baby wipes, Fiskars scissors (labeled), "classic" markers, colored pencils, 8 dry-erase markers, 2 highlighters (any color), 1 single subject notebook (wide ruled), 1 pack loof-leaf paper (**WIDE RULED**), 1 pack of post-it notes and 3 packs (100 count) 3x5 plain white index cards.

GRADE 3 - School bag, 2 Pink Pearl erasers, 1 Elmer's school glue, 4 large glue sticks, 3 packages of 12 count #2 plain yellow pencils (**decorative pencils jam in our pencil sharpener**, **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**), 6 folders(not plastic) with pockets and fasteners, box of (24) crayons, classic markers, colored pencils, 8 dry erase markers, Fiskars scissors (labeled), 1 pkg. of loose leaf paper (**WIDE RULED**), pencil pouch (**no boxes**), 3 large boxes of tissues, 1 tub of baby wipes, 1 single subject spiral notebook (**WIDE RULED**), 2 highlighters and \$3 for a recorder for music class, 3 packs (100 count) 3x5 plain white index cards and 2 packs of post-it notes.

GRADE 4 - Crayons, 1 bottle of glue, 3 glue sticks, ruler (showing inches and cm), 3 regular size boxes of tissues, 1 set **primary colored** markers, 1 pkg. **primary colored** construction paper, 1 shorthand steno pad, 3 packages of 12 count #2 pencils (**NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**), small school box: **no larger than 8 ½"L X 5 ½"W X 3"H**, 2 pink peral erasers, Fiskars scissors, 2 single subject spiral notebook (**WIDE RULED**), 1 pkg. loose-leaf paper (**WIDE RULED**), 5 folders **with pockets & fasteners**, 4 red pencils or pens, 1 pack (100 count) 3x5 plain white index cards, 1 dry erase marker and 1 pack of post-it notes.

Kindergarten Supplies

- 1 box of 8 count crayons
- 2 boxes of 16 or 24 count crayons
- 12 pencils (regular size) - sharpened
- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars brand works best)
- 2 **large** Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 standard eraser (pink pearl are the best)
- 2 packages of 8 washable markers (**classic** colors)
- 3 dry erase markers
- 3 two-pocket folders
- 1 large zippered pencil pouch (see-through front) or pencil box
- 1 bath towel (for rest time)
- 1 school bag/backpack (full size)
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 1 inch binder
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1-25 pack of card stock (white)
